Exigent Circumstances Re: Credit Counseling has been renamed, *Certification of Exigent Circumstances*. This docketing event is still found in the Miscellaneous Events category. The docket text has been modified to read:

Certification of Exigent Circumstances and Request for Extension of Time to Obtain Credit Counseling filed by [Attorney Name] on behalf of [Debtor Name].

NEW CM/ECF EVENTS:

Certification in Support of Discharge is found in the Miscellaneous Events category. To view the related **NEW FORM**, follow the links on our website, *Forms → Miscellaneous Forms → Certification in Support of Discharge*.

MODIFIED CM/ECF EVENT:

The *Electronic Fee Payment* event, found in the Miscellaneous Events category, is currently used to pay a filing fee that is due upon entry of a court order. This occurs when a case converts to a Chapter 11 and when a case is severed. The event has been modified to allow for payment of two new options: (1) *Entire Chapter 11 Fee* (2) *Entire Chapter 13 Fee*. These options are to be used when a Chapter 7 case converts to either Chapter 11 or 13 and an Order Waiving the Chapter 7 filing fee was entered at the time of case opening. The NEW conversion orders contain language that revokes an Order Waiving the Chapter 7 filing fee and directs payment of the new filing fee.
