NOTICE TO THE BAR AND PUBLIC REGARDING CHANGES TO BANKRUPTCY COURT FEES

The Temporary Bankruptcy Judgeships Extension Act of 2012 (Pub.L. No. 112-121) was signed into law by the President on May 25, 2012. This law includes a provision that increases the fee for filing a bankruptcy case under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code. The statutory filing fee to file a case under Chapter 11 will increase to \$1,167. The total fee for filing a Chapter 11 case will increase to \$1,213 (statutory fee of \$1,167 plus the administrative fee of \$46).

As a result of the Chapter 11 filing fee increase, the fees noted below will also increase. The changes become effective November 21, 2012.
