## GENERAL ORDER CONCERNING PROPOSED D.N.J. LBR 1015-1, JOINT ADMINISTRATION OF CASES

The Court having determined the need for a Local Rule concerning the joint administration of cases, it is hereby:

**ORDERED** that pending formal adoption of proposed D.N.J. LBR 1015-1, *Joint Administration of Cases* under the Court's Annual Rule Making Cycle, a petition filed by an individual debtor may not be amended at a later time to add a spouse as a joint debtor. The spouse may file a separate voluntary petition, and move for joint administration of the cases.
