U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Jersey Announces Clerk's Office Public Access

The United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Jersey announces limited Clerk's Office public access in all courthouses in the District as a result of the COVID-19 virus (coronavirus) outbreak in New Jersey.

The Centers for Disease Control has advised people to take precautions in light of the COVID-19 virus outbreak and noted that the best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to this virus. Therefore, effective March 18, 2020, access to the Clerk's Office for the District will be as follows:
