UPDATED COVID-19 PROTOCOLS
AND EXPANDED OFFICE HOURS

Please be advised that, in accordance with District Court Standing Order 2022-01, dated March 16, 2022, masks and/or social distancing will no longer be required of persons seeking entry to or occupying the public areas of Court facilities within the District of New Jersey.¹ Notwithstanding, visitors will continue to be allowed entry to Court facilities **only** upon proof of full vaccination or negative COVID-19 test results.² For further details, please refer to District Court Standing Order 2022-01, attached hereto for ease of reference.

Please also take note that, **effective March 21, 2022**, in-person front counter office hours for each vicinage of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Jersey will be expanded to Monday through Friday, on a limited basis, as set forth below.

¹ Pursuant to District Court Standing Order 2022-01, a presiding judicial officer may, for any reason, direct that appropriate face coverings or masks be worn, during in-Court proceeding before that Judge. See District Court Standing Order 2022-01, paragraph 5.

² Visitors seeking entry to Court facilities by way of the testing option may present proof of a negative result from a rapid test, rather than a PCR test, along with proof of identification. See District Court Standing Order 2022-01, paragraph 9.
