## NOTICE TO THE BAR \& PUBLIC RE: PROOF OF CLAIM

Pursuant to the Bankruptcy Reform Act, several amendments to the Bankruptcy Code became effective immediately. Section 1401 increases the wage priority cap from $\$ 4,000$ to $\$ 10,000$ and expands the look-back period from 90 to 180 days. Accordingly, Official Form 10, Proof of Claim, has been amended and is posted on our court's web site: www.njb.uscourts.gov.
