

### **OBJECTION TO DEBTOR'S CLAIM OF EXEMPTIONS**

This event is programmed in CM/ECF to automatically transmit statistical information to the Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts pursuant to statutory mandates of BAPCPA. Please be sure this is the most appropriate event for the pleading you are e:filing.

The instructions below are written as an attorney's objection. This event is also found under the **Trustee Events** category and the docketing steps are slightly different as noted below.

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**STEP 1** Choose **Bankruptcy** from main menu

**STEP 2** Choose **Response/Objection** category

**STEP 3** Click on **Reference an Existing Motion/Application**

☛ *TIP - Step 3 does not occur in the Trustee Event.*

**STEP 4** Enter case number; click [NEXT]

**STEP 5** Select **Objection to Debtor's Claim of Exemptions**; click [NEXT]

**STEP 6** If this is a joint filing, place a check in the box; click [NEXT]. If this is not a joint filing, click [NEXT] to skip this screen.

☛ *TIP - Step 6 does not occur in the Trustee Event.*

**STEP 7** Select Party or click [ADD/CREATE PARTY]; click [NEXT].

☛ *TIP - Trustees should select their name on this screen and click [NEXT] on the screen stating, "The following attorney/party associations do not exist . . .".*

☛ *TIP - If this is the first time an attorney is appearing on behalf of this party, place a check in the box to create the association. Failure to place a check in the box results in the attorney not receiving NEFs in this case.*

**STEP 8** Upload PDF file; click [NEXT]

**STEP 9** Confirm case name and number; click [NEXT]

**STEP 10** Docket text appears; review for accuracy, modify if appropriate; click [NEXT]

☛ *TIP - Text of docket entry cannot be modified from this screen. If there is an error, abort the transaction and begin again.*
