

Third Circuit Judicial Conference

The Sixty-First Judicial Conference will be held from Sunday, November 11th through Tuesday, November 13th at the Loews Hotel in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. This Conference is open to all attorneys in the Third Circuit.

The Conference will address issues of importance to the administration of justice in the Third Circuit. The Task Force on Selection of Class Counsel will present its preliminary report after having received presentations at public hearings from judges, professors and attorneys from across the country.
