THIS MATTER having been brought before the Court upon the motion (“Motion”) of creditor Susan E. Champion, Esq. (“Movant”), by and through her counsel, Hunziker, Jones & Sweeney, P.A., seeking an Order dismissing the bankruptcy case of the Blanche Zwerdling Revocable Living Trust (“Debtor” or “Trust”); and Opposition having been filed by Todd Trombetta on behalf of the Debtor, by and through counsel, Law Office of Piotr Rapciewicz, LLC and co-counsel, LaGrotta Law, LLC; and Joinder to the Motion having been filed by Linda Couso Puccio, Esq., Tania M. Nemeth, Esq., and Joseph Mecca, Esq., as creditors; and the Court having considered the moving papers and the opposition; and the Court having heard oral argument; and having issued its opinion dated June 11, 2015, the Court hereby finds as follows:

1. The Trust is ineligible for bankruptcy relief under 11 U.S.C. § 109 as the Trust does not meet the definition of “person” pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 101(41); and it is hereby
