

CHANGES TO DOLLAR AMOUNTS ON OFFICIAL BANKRUPTCY FORMS EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2007. The following forms are amended to reflect the automatic adjustment of certain dollar amounts pursuant to the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005:

- Official Form 1, Voluntary Petition
- Official Form 6C, Schedule of Property Claimed as Exempt
- Official Form 6E, Schedule of Creditors Holding Claims Entitled to Priority
- Official Form 7, Statement of Financial Affairs
- Official Form 10. Proof of Claim
- Official Form 22A, Statement of Current Monthly Income and Means Test Calculation (Chapter 7)
- Official Form 22C, Statement of Current Monthly Income and Calculation of Commitment Period and Disposable Income (Chapter 13)

The amended forms are **mandatory** for cases filed on or after April 1, 2007. Please see the Notice to Bar and Public dated March 27, 2007 posted on our website. The amended forms will be available on our website under the Official Bankruptcy Forms and Instructions link. Failure to use the amended forms will result in a Deficiency Notice from the court. Please also be aware that the amended Proof of Claim form will be available in fillable format under Our Court's Misc. Forms.
